



**Tallahassee Fire Protection District
Minutes of the Board of Directors
Regular Monthly Public BOD Meeting & Public Hearing
August 14, 2023**

David Levy called the Regular Monthly Public Meeting to order at 2:00 p.m., on August 14, 2023.

Directors Present: David Levy, Tammy Becht, Christopher Parker Judith Schmidt. Kristen Sanders was participating via telephone. A quorum is present.

Directors Absent: None

Firefighters/Volunteers Present: Chief Mark Norris

Public Present: Dr Steve & Leigh Bohannon

Purpose of Regular Monthly Public Meeting: To discuss agenda items for the regular monthly Board of Directors Meeting & to hold a Public Hearing.

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL – Quorum established (at least 3 Directors Present)

PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was held to discuss the 2nd amendment of the 2023 annual budget. The public notice for the hearing was posted in the Daily Record as well as on the TFPD website following notification requirements. The budget was also posted on the website and at the Main Station. No members of the public had input regarding the amended budget.

Motion: David Levy made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-07 for the 2nd amendment to the 2023 Annual Budget. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

PUBLIC INPUT

No members of the public had any input for the regular BOD meeting.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

David Levy asked Tammy Becht if there were any needs she had for the secretary position or if she needed any additional support. Tammy stated she felt things were going well and did not have any issues or needs.

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Christopher Parker to approve the Regular Board Meeting Minutes of July 10, 2023. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Chris Parker shared some talking points regarding the Treasurer's Report:

1. The District decreased its cash position before reserves this month to \$146,695. The QB checking account cash balance, before reserves, as of June 30, 2023, was \$168,148.
2. Chris paid the USPS box fee of \$310.
3. Chris moved \$23,427 out of Committed funds as previously discussed.
4. He explained the credit card decline in available credit. He stated that even when payments are made, it does not increase the amount of available credit for use until the month rolls over to a new month. He stated this could negatively impact the volunteers out on deployment if they needed to charge hotel or gas expenses and the credit card did not have available credit. Chris was going to have the limit increased on the card so that the District would not be impacted.

5. Chris discussed the reimbursement claim that was made for the required insurance through the Colorado Heart & Lung Cancer coverage. \$185 was received for that.
6. Due to expensed and deployments Chris stated a cash transfer of \$20K was made from the Bank of San Juan to the Wells Fargo bank for payroll.

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Tamara Becht to approve the Treasurer's Report for July's Financial Statements, 2023. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Dave Levy and Chris Parker attended the Canon City Fire Station Open House and were able to tour the new station. They were impressed by their operation and the new building. By comparison, the Canon City Fire Dept had 40 calls in the last 12 days.

OLD BUSINESS

The upcoming Open House for the TFPD was discussed. Chief Norris stated the event was promoted by Facebook posts and a flyer was posted in the paper to notify the public. He stated everything was set up and ready as far as vendors and food trucks. Volunteers and the board members were asked to arrive early to help with set up.

NEW BUSINESS

There were no new business items presented.
