



Tallahassee Fire Protection District Minutes of the Board of Directors Regular Monthly Public BOD Meeting September 11, 2023

David Levy called the Regular Monthly Public Meeting to order at 2:00 p.m., on September 11, 2023.

Directors Present: David Levy, Christopher Parker, Tamara Becht. Kristen Sanders was present via telephone

A quorum is present.

Directors Absent: Judith Schmidt had an excused absence.

Firefighters/Volunteers Present: Chief Mark Norris

Public Present: Leigh Bohannon & Dee Turney

Purpose of Regular Monthly Public Meeting: To discuss agenda items for the regular monthly Board of Directors Meeting.

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL – Quorum established (at least 3 Directors Present)

PUBLIC INPUT

No members of the public had input for the meeting.

David Levy began the meeting stating that the Board recognizes this anniversary date, September 11, 2023, as a reminder that our lives can change in an instant. We will forever keep this date and the remembrance of those that lost their lives and the many heroes that helped that day, in our hearts and prayers.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Christopher Parker to approve the Regular Board Meeting Minutes of August 14, 2023. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Chris pointed out certain items on the lead sheet to the Treasurer's Report:

1. The District decreased its cash position before reserves this month to \$102,949. The QB checking account cash balance, before reserves, as of July 31, 2023, was \$146,695.

2. Discuss budget revision for the 3rd amendment of 2023 budget. The District had more deployment income and expenses therefore another revision will need to be made. Chris presented a draft of this revision and the board spent time reviewing and discussing the changes. All were in agreement to the changes and will hold a Public Hearing Monday September 25, 2023 to present the changes to the public for input. Tammy Becht will place the public notice in the paper and post online and at the Main Station as well.

3. Electronic transfers now available which will make things much easier. They can be done remotely rather than needing to be in person.

4. Additional controls on the Square – Chris shared that he was able to view deposits that were made from the Square app but it did not detail who those deposits were from. He recommended having a system in place that shares the name of the person making the donation or purchase. The Board agreed.

5. Discuss email deletion policy- Chris was reviewing his past emails looking for an important report sent to him and it was already deleted due to the previously approved 90 day automatic deletion policy. He was able to obtain a copy of the report another way but asked if we should review this 90 day deletion policy. The Board discussed this and it was shared by everyone that after working with the 90 day deletion policy for quite some time, it seemed to be too short of a timeframe, esp if something was important that was needed and it was forgotten to be placed in the Do Not Delete Folder. It was agreed upon that a deletion policy after 1 year would be more practical and helpful.

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Kristen Sanders to increase the dates of the automatic deletion policy of all emails to one year. And all emails will be deleted after one year unless placed in a file labeled DONOTDELETE. Resolution 2023-009 will accompany this motion and presented and signed at the next meeting.

6. Mill Levy Certificate is due December 15th.

7. Worker's Compensation review for the District is underway. Chris and Dave are doing a good service for the District by reviewing the current workers comp terms and rates and reviewing other insurance companies to compare rates.

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Tamara Becht to approve the Treasurer's Report for August's Financial Statements, 2023. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Kristen Sanders to approve the proposed 3rd Budget Revision to be presented at the next Public Hearing meeting September 25, 2023. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

- Stop the Bleed for the community is being scheduled based on instructor availability.
- Water tanks at the Canyon Springs station are mostly buried. Weather and Fire Restrictions stopped progress. Final connections need to be installed and burial completed. Brian and Karl were leading this project so there will be continuing delays until we get up to speed.

Motion: It was moved by David Levy and seconded by Christopher Parker to accept the operations report for August 2023. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

David Levy began by reviewing the processes with deployments and asked Chief Norris for clarification. The Chief stated the volunteers out on deployment buy their own meals and get reimbursed a flat rate by the state upon approval. He is monitoring charges being made on the credit card as well as hotel charges and vehicle usage. He stated 60% of the revenue goes towards firefighter payroll. Payments are received after the state reviews the bills for deployments.

Dave then stated that questions have arisen from the public in the past wondering if volunteer resources are lacking to cover the District due to sending out firefighters to other parts of the country to help. Chief Norris stated that is not the case. Volunteer firefighters being sent on deployments reside outside of the District and it does not affect coverage locally.

Dave stated that we are doing and will continue to do everything possible to review all systems and procedures on a regular basis to make sure the District is following regulations in regards to deployments.

OLD BUSINESS

The 2023 Open House in August was discussed in detail. It was noted that attendance was down this year compared to past events. TFPD personalized items such as pens, hats, fire blankets, etc were offered for a donation. Marketing was reviewed and it was noted that a flyer was placed in the paper as well as on the Facebook page. Email advertising was discussed as an option for next year to possibly increase the number of people who might see the advertisement.

NEW BUSINESS

Christopher Parker has started working on the 2024 budget with input from Chief Norris and David Levy. This will be presented at the next BOD meeting for review and discussion by the Board and a Public Hearing will be held at the November 2023 BOD meeting for public input.
