From Captain Jim Rice: Additional Stipends for Responders: Firefighter Cayden Stahr and Lt. Toby Bryant: Extraordinary effort and commitment during weather emergency Firefighter Stahr: an additional \$100.00 stipend allowance for emergency response to cover for disabled responder to serve the people of Fremont County.

Lt. Bryant: an additional \$1,000.00 stipend allowance for dedicated and committed service at great personal risk and exhaustion during a dangerous weather emergency over a three day period. Lt. Bryant responded, alone, to calls for service, and then with Capt. Rice, he responded to a serious traffic accident and an extended rescue of stranded individuals.

The district and board are in favor on this stipend.

The Board had a discussion of the possibility in the future, to purchase a side by side that could be with tracks for snow and interchange with tires. A dual purpose vehicle. Mainly due to all the storms lately.




