



Tallahassee Fire Protection District Minutes of the Board of Directors Regular/Hybrid Meeting January 10, 2022

Scott Fullerton called the Regular/Hybrid Meeting to order at 2:04 p.m., on January 10, 2022.

Directors Present: Scott Fullerton, Christopher Parker, Brad Nelson (In-person @ TFPD Main Station), and Cynthia Boyle, Harvey Ammel (by teleconference).
A quorum is present.

Directors Absent: None

Firefighters/Volunteers Present: Chief Mark Norris (In-person @ TFPD Main Station)

Public Present: Donna Toeroek and Dave Levy (In-person @ TFPD Main Station)

Purpose of Regular/Hybrid Meeting: To discuss agenda items for the regular monthly Board of Directors Meeting.

PUBLIC INPUT:

Members of the public included Donna Toeroek (2022 Designated Elections Official and former TFPD President) and Dave Levy (prospective appointed TFPD Board member).

Dave Levy chose not to address the Board.

Donna Toeroek (300 Rustlers Ridge Road, Canon City, CO) stated that as President, she and the Board at that time approved the lease purchase of the Freightliner vehicle thinking that it would pay for itself through deployments. As that has not happened, she supports possibly surplus or excessing the vehicle with any monies gained or saved going toward the purchase of newer EMS response vehicles. She has identified a used EMS response vehicle that is for sale at a good price and it has lights and sirens – which is a step up from her personal vehicle. She is willing to purchase on her own and when the time comes, sell it back to TFPD at her purchase price.

Scott thanked Donna for her comments. During the remainder of this Board Meeting, Donna will be speaking as our Designated Elections Official and/or at the request of the Board. Any such discussions should not be misinterpreted as public input.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Chris gave a briefing on the Treasurer's Report. At this time, the December and year-end financial statements are preliminary drafts. Following completion of the formal year-end close, a final and formal financial report will be submitted for discussion at the February Board Meeting.

- The District saw a decrease in its fund balance by \$9K.
- Our revenue is down as we have already received all property tax revenue; yet our expenses remained the same.
- Our cash balance is \$132K.

Chris further stated that he has purchased the QuickBooks Online license and we have opened two bank accounts (checking and money market) at the Bank of the San Juans.

In review of the Balance Sheet:

- For Cash, we are \$11K up from 2020.
- Property Tax Receivable is up \$21K from 2020.
- Pointed out that the Unrestricted Net Assets total is not spendable money. It is equipment less depreciation.
- Total Equity is \$746K vs. \$708K in 2020.

In review of the P&L Budget vs. Actual YTD (all preliminary numbers):

- For Gross Revenue, we are \$9K above budget.
- Administrative Expenses are \$4K below budget.
- Personnel is \$7K below budget.
- Fire Operations is \$6K above budget.
- EMS Operations and Building Expenses were a push.
- Utilities came in at \$1.5K below budget.
- Operations Expenses were about \$4.5K below budget.
- Total Expenditures are \$20K below budget.

Scott clarified that regarding the 2nd amendment to the FY 2021 Budget, we assumed another deployment was going to occur in December. However, the responder was not called up. Therefore, we did not incur that portion of deployment income or expense.

Scott stated there remains approximately a \$5K gap between property tax receivables and actual receipts. The County has been very helpful and believes part of the discrepancy is related to actual assessment changes. Currently, trying to figure out what documents we can use going forward that will help us predict any gaps and actual tax income for budget purposes. He hopes to have additional details from the County by the February Board Meeting.

Scott still needs to add 2022 budget targets into QuickBooks by account. Payroll documents have been filed with the IRS and the state. W-2's will go out toward the end of this week. The Workers' Compensation audit information has been uploaded and should be submitted tomorrow.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Motion: It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to approve the Public Hearing and Regular Board Meeting Minutes of December 13, 2021. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Update on Status of Year-End Filings: Cindy stated that all year-end filings are complete and were approved by legal. Documents were e-filed to DOLA, emailed to Fremont County Offices, and websites have been updated.

Motion: It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adopt Resolution 2022-001 as written, which designates posting locations for public agenda notices. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Briefing on possible changes to Discretionary 2022 Budget Priorities to accelerate Acquisition of Property and/or Response Vehicles: Scott wanted to alert the Board to possible discretionary changes to the FY 2022 Budget. Since completing the 2022 budget:

- We have received an offer to purchase property for water tanks and a station.
 - So far, there are no obstacles. Acquisition expenses are approximately \$11K - \$12K.
- There has been discussion concerning accelerating replacement of the Blazers due to wear and tear and/or inflation.
 - Chief Norris to put together a list of specs for vehicles.
 - What are the potential sources and are there purchase opportunities through other agencies?
 - What are the vehicle costs + any potential upgrades?
 - Any opportunities for a phased acquisition?
 - Should we sell any of our current equipment?
- Potential effects of the Deployments Business Plan.
 - What is the effect on cash flow?
 - What effect does it have on the Freightliner (leased vehicle)?
- Decision regarding the Freightliner leased engine.
 - Will we keep it, buy it out, or terminate it?
 - Will it be used for deployments, district use only, or both?
 - What is the effect on cash flow?
- Suggested changes to compensation policies for Responders, Fire Chief, and Board members.

Between now and the February Board Meeting, we need to think through pet projects and the effects the above bullet points could have.

OPERATIONS REPORT:

Chief Norris discussed the highlights of the December Operations Report which included project status:

- 8 incidents in December; 147 total incidents for 2021. There were 146 total incidents in 2020, so we maintained the same level of call volume. The most common call type was motor vehicle accidents and comprised about 45% of total calls.
- 14 active members.
- Swamp cooler has arrived which was a restricted donation.
- Water tanks at Canyon Springs has been delayed due to scheduling and weather issues.
- Need to finalize the HOA handout for fire restrictions with Cindy.
- Non-monetary donations are updated.
- We stayed consistent with our EMTs and EMRs.
- Response times – Average arrival @ 8.45 minutes for December; 13.16 minutes YTD average for 2021.
- We did not list any engines for deployment in 2021 because we did not have crews.

Deployments have been very complicated and difficult due to COVID as a lot of people did not want to deploy. In 2021, mass resignations and layoffs impacted the National Wildfire Coordinating Group in managing deployments. Contractors are now paying more than the Colorado reimbursement rate. So, fire departments are losing firefighters if they do not match these higher wages and they lose the 10% over. There are some options we have to increase the wages. We are still trying to research how other agencies are able to pay more for Incident Management Team Deployable Members. We are trying to get an engine out by seeing what we can offer to pay, but it appears we would need to bump up each engine position by two pay grades. Do we want to continue our deployment program? If not, we need to get rid of the leased Freightliner.

Scott stated that we are trying to get confirmation from the state as to what happens if payments are greater than scale wage. The state will only pay out to a certain wage. We need to find out what the cap is. Should we decide to proceed with deployments, we will write up a scenario and send it to the state for confirmation that they will pay based on the scenario.

Scott complimented Jenn Judd and her knowledge of the deployment system. We have a great person acting as our Deployment Coordinator.

Chief Norris clarified that the state does not pay the wage; it acts as a third-party billing service. The incident pays for the resource.

Chief Norris is open to any discussion concerning the engines and deployments.

We are downsizing the number of apparatus we have. We have three apparatus the Board has already approved for sale. E56 will sell this year which is valued at approximately \$3K. We have two interested buyers. We have a 6 x 6 truck we need to sell. E313 is approved to sell, but we are currently using it.

Brad questioned the status of the two ATVs and the generators. We need to figure out if the ATVs are repairable. Greg Cook is working on one; need to figure out the value of the other one. Both are offsite. Karl is working on two smaller generators; thinks battery replacements will get them working. They are offsite too. Thinking at this point is that we will use one generator as back-up for the Main Station; the other for Canyon Springs. We are trying to sell the large, unused generator that is behind the station as it is too overpowered for our needs.

Chief Norris informed the Board that he is no longer with his previous employer and is currently seeking employment. In interviewing, it appears as though a new job would not allow him to respond to all calls and would force him to back away from the fire department which he does not want to do. He would like to further his fire career. He is requesting the Board to have a Study Session to discuss what we could pay a full-time Fire Chief.

Finally, Chief Norris needs to talk to Scott concerning Donna's request to have POV lights and sirens.

Chief Norris continues to work on having the exhaust fan fixed in the Main Station.

NEW BUSINESS: (Moved up the agenda by Scott.)

Revisit Discussion of Full-time vs. Part-time Chief: Per previous discussion, Scott requested Chief Norris to email the Board members his proposal for a full-time Fire Chief position. In turn, the Board will schedule a Study Session to discuss the proposal and other related matters.

Scott asked the Board to look at the Actual vs. Budget pages of the preliminary Treasurer's Report, and in particular, Account #4052 Shift Coverage. In any given year, our difference between actual to budget should be zero as we take the number of shifts/year x the rate/shift – unless personnel opt not to receive a stipend for their time on shift. In 2021, we have a gap of \$5,405 based on our original budget (before amendments). Original budget of \$32,850 – the actual of \$27,445 = \$5,405 difference. This difference exists because Chief Norris was filling in for shifts that others did not want. Normally, we would have paid out a stipend for these hours for whoever was manning these shifts. Under the Fire Chief's Employment Agreement, he cannot be compensated via stipend.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Brad Nelson that as part of the FY 2021 close, we reserve the \$5,405 as a 2021 expense and close the year accordingly.

We need to figure out how much of that total is owed to the Fire Chief. If and when paid out, it would go against FY 2021 expenses. This allows us to correct the omission, if we choose to do so, pending further discussion at a formal meeting.

There being no additional discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES:

Resignation of Bradley Nelson: As of the close of this Board Meeting, Brad will resign from the Board due to family health and work issues. Brad would like to remain a reserve Firefighter and hopes to help out as much as possible. He will also continue doing the address signs for the TFPD community. His wife, Robin, has chosen to continue helping out with the District Welcome Letters. All Board members thanked Brad for his service and wished his family well. Scott, in particular, thanked Brad for all the expertise, advice and friendship Brad offered him. Brad will be sorely missed, but we look forward to seeing him at future TFPD events. THANK YOU, BRAD AND ROBIN! ALL THE BEST!

Changing the Date and Time of Regular Board Meetings:

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Havey Ammel to post Notice that for 2022 the day and time for the regular Board Meetings will be on the second Monday of each month, beginning at 2:00 p.m.

Scott explained that our Bylaws require us to post this information every January. He recommends that we approve the above for now, but we need to get input from any individuals that turn in a Self-Nomination Form to join the Board as to what is convenient for them. We will revisit at the February Board Meeting.

There being no additional discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Donations: The District received \$215 in unrestricted donations in December; of which \$100 was earmarked for the TFPD Community Safety Program. YTD donations total \$6,422 -- compared to \$4,731 received YTD in 2020. We received approximately \$1,700 more in unrestricted donations for 2021. The anonymous restricted donation of \$19,014.76 for an Extractor and Air Dryer was officially booked as receipt of a physical asset (non-cash) which was placed in-service in December.

2022 Q1 Statutory District To-Do List: This list has been updated to show tasks beginning in 2022. We need to file for the Audit Exemption and file Workers' Compensation materials.

OLD BUSINESS:

2022 Election Update: Donna clarified to the Board that due to Brad's resignation during an election year (and before publication of the Call for Nominations), we must show three Board positions available in May. Two positions are for three-year terms and one is for a one-year term to complete Brad's term. The Self-Nomination Form has been revised accordingly.

Motion: It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adopt Resolution 2022-002 as written, which calls for the 2022 Regular District Election and appoints a Designated Elections Official. This resolution replaces Resolution 2021-010 in its entirety due to the above discussion. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Election of Board Officers: Scott stated that at the February Board Meeting, we will make an Appointment (for Brad's term) and elect a TFPD Vice President at that time. After a short discussion (with input from Donna) it was agreed that we will hold another election of Officer positions in May – after the May election.

Scott plans on resigning as TFPD President no later than May and will run for TFPD Treasurer at that time.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Brad Nelson that the current Officers agree to their current capacities until the Board decides that another election of Officers needs to be held.

There being no additional discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Director's Reports: Scott informed the Board that our General Counsel disagrees strongly with the suggestion that the Auxiliary Committee should become a 501(c)(3) organization. There are more effective ways to have the Auxiliary under the umbrella of the Special District but it is dependent on exactly what the Auxiliary's role is, what their activities are going to be, etc. Due to other priorities, Scott recommends tabling this discussion for another month or two. There were no objections from the remaining Board members.

NEXT PUBLIC MEETING:

The next regular TFPD Board Meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 14, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. (by hybrid meeting unless revised), at the Main Station.

MOTION TO ADJOURN:

It was moved by Brad Nelson and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adjourn the meeting at 3:28 p.m. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.
