



## Tallahassee Fire Protection District Minutes of the Board of Directors Regular/Hybrid Meeting October 11, 2021

Scott Fullerton called the Regular/Hybrid Meeting to order at 2:00 p.m., on October 11, 2021.

**Directors Present:** Brad Nelson, Christopher Parker, Cynthia Boyle, Harvey Ammel

**Purpose of Regular/Hybrid Meeting:** To discuss agenda items for the regular monthly Board  
of Directors Meeting.

### **PUBLIC INPUT:**

No members of the public were present either in-person or by teleconference call.

### **SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

**Motion:** It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to approve the regular Board Meeting Minutes for September 13, 2021. There was no discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT:**

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to approve the Treasurer's Report for September 2021. Chris discussed the Treasurer's Report. Revenues are up, Administrative Expenses are up, Payroll Taxes are up due to deployments, and our Net Revenue/Profit is up \$30K. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

The Motion to accept the proposed 2022 Budget, schedule a Public Hearing for the proposed 2022 Budget on November 8, and post/publish Notice was tabled. Chief Norris gave some additional feedback to Scott concerning the budget earlier today. Scott to send a revised draft to Chris for his review. Upon his review, the remaining Board Members will receive a draft budget copy. It was agreed to schedule a Special Session Hybrid Meeting on Wednesday, October 13, 2021, at 7:30 pm, to review and accept the proposed 2022 Budget. Cindy is to prepare the Special Notice and post accordingly. Once the proposed 2022 Budget is accepted, a Hybrid Public Hearing will be held on November 8, 2021, for the adoption of the 2022 Budget.

**Motion:** It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Brad Nelson to review and accept the proposed 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget at the Special Session Hybrid Meeting scheduled for October 13, 2021. An Amendment is needed primarily due to the unexpected revenue/expense stream from deployments, thereby exceeding the total appropriation declared for 2021. After a short discussion, the Board agreed to schedule a Hybrid Public Hearing on October 27, 2021, at 7:30 pm., in order to adopt the 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

## **Investment Fund Q&A:**

At 2:25 pm, Brent Turner, from COLOTRUST, joined the Meeting by teleconference call. He gave a synopsis of COLOTRUST stating this it is Colorado's oldest and largest Local Government Investment Pool ("LGIP"). LGIPs are statutory trusts that the State of Colorado allows local governments to create by pooling their assets together. There are three LGIPs in Colorado – with COLOTRUST being one of them. They have been in business since 1985 and currently manage about \$12.6 billion dollars of Colorado local government money. They serve approximately 125 fire protection districts. COLOTRUST offers three different portfolios – COLOTRUST PLUS+ and PRIME (both are daily, liquid money market style funds) and COLOTRUST EDGE (enhanced cash portfolio which has weekly liquidity). COLOTRUST PLUS+ and PRIME are currently yielding .02% on a daily yield and COLOTRUST EDGE is yielding .15% on a weekly yield. These interest rates will probably carry into next summer.

Chris and other Board members then entered into a Q&A session with Mr. Turner:

- There is no minimum balance.
- Establish authorized signers with restrictions and dual authorizations.
- Have robust security controls.
- Investments are extremely conservative – treasury bills, government agencies and government sponsored enterprises, commercial paper.
- Governed by 13 Board of Trustees.
- They do not purchase anything beyond 12 months.
- No FDIC; money is not insured.
- Management fee is a flat annual fee and is 12 basis points (\$120 on a \$100K investment).
- COLOTRUST PLUS+ and PRIME – get money back same day if request is in portal by 11:00 am. Weighted average maturity is 54 days.
- COLOTRUST EDGE – get money back in 5 business days. Weighted average maturity is 170 days.
- Recommends opening a COLOTRUST PLUS+ and COLOTRUST EDGE account.
- No indemnity clause.

Teleconference call with Brent Turner ended at 2:45 pm, and he left the Meeting.

At 2:47 pm, Bob Krug, from CSAFE, joined the Meeting by teleconference call. He gave a synopsis of CSAFE which began in 1988. They would work in conjunction with our local bank when an account is set up. They set up a repeat code for our bank and it's the only place funds would go back to. They are a AAA rated trust. CSAFE operates two funds: CSAFE Cash acts as a money market fund; Colorado Core is more of a savings fund. They are overseen by several different oversight entities – one of which is the State of Colorado's Division of Securities. They act very similarly to a money market fund. Their Board of Trustees represent different segments of the public sector. Most entities use CSAFE for their savings funds. CSAFE is a dollar-for-dollar backing of all the securities. Securities are all State regulated and include government treasury notes, treasury bills, government agency securities, CD's and commercial paper.

Chris and other Board members then entered into a Q&A session with Mr. Turner:

- For the rate of return, CSAFE Cash is paying between 1 and 2 basis points; Colorado Core is paying between 4 and 5 basis points.
- There are no hard fees. They get paid out of the interest earnings and average 12 basis points.
- US Bank acts as the CSAFE checking account and trust account.
- Have a secure portal for authorized users only and money can only go back to the local bank account.

- US Bank knows CSAFE as a pooled account only. They do not have any records of participants.
- US Bank guarantees everything on the checking side. On the trust side, for the invested funds, we would be an undivided shareholder; dollar-for-dollar of the investments.
- Minimum investment in CSAFE Cash is \$50K with unlimited transactions; in Colorado Core it's \$100K with three monthly transactions.
- Majority of their entities are in Colorado Core.
- CSAFE Cash – get money back the same day.
- Colorado Core – get money back with a one-day notification. Weighted average maturity is 49 days. Weighted average life is 128 days.
- They serve approximately 15 fire districts and 200 special districts.
- Regarding an indemnification clause in their draft resolution (Why would we need to indemnify you?), it is there to identify how deposits and withdrawals are managed. We should be able to cancel this clause from our resolution.
- Questions were raised regarding higher rates of return from other FDIC fully insured “safe” investment options available through banks compared to the trust fund. Scott reminded everyone that it is TFPD’s obligation to ensure that any invested monies are compliant with the statute. It is not the bank’s obligation. Bank officials at the local and regional level may not be aware of the restricted options for public funds.
- Bob Krug stated he would email a copy of the eligible investments per the State statute.

Teleconference call with Bob Krug ended at 3:04 pm, and he left the Meeting.

A brief discussion ensued as to the benefit of opening a trust account. Scott stated that it is important for TFPD to diversify its funds among several institutions given recent cyber threats affecting accessibility and to make sure that move provides the most benefit to TFPD. Chief Norris brought up the idea of investing in ladder CD’s. Chris agreed to do additional research into other investment options.

### **TREASURER’S REPORT (Continued):**

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to obtain QuickBooks online licenses and to begin that conversion during this fiscal year at a date to be determined. There was no discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

### **OPERATIONS REPORT:**

There was no discussion concerning the August Operations Report.

Chief Norris discussed the highlights of the September Operations Report:

- 12 incidents in September; 117 total incidents for 2021. Most of the incidents were in-district.
- 13 active members -- 1 Probationary, 4 Recruits, 2 Reserves, 7 IMT Deployable Members, 7 Auxiliary Members.
- Challenge Coins – Still working on the individualized coins. Hopes to have the coins in-hand for Christmas to hand out as gifts to our responders.
- Water tanks @ Canyon Springs – Need to get the risers done.
- HOA Presentations Handout/Burning – Found a graphic that the county and the EM are using. Will forward the graphic to Cindy.
- SBS UTV Project/Polaris – There is no need to continue pursuing this grant.
- Smokey the Bear Sign – The rider issue has been taken care of and they now fit.

- We have 3 EMTs & 3 EMRs. Still working on trying to have an EMT class at the Station.
- Response times – Average arrival @ 10.40 minutes for September; 12.33 minutes YTD. Monthly response time down due to most incidents being in-district.

Scott explained why certain income categories for the revised 2021 Budget went down. Deployment Income is lower due to most incidents being in-district. Donations (which includes miscellaneous income and sales) are lower as it was decided not to sell certain trucks.

Chief Norris and the Board would like to commend Karl on his bravery and valor in his response to a dangerous incident call.

Chief Norris stated that due to a recent theft of fuel, we will be updating the security systems at the Station. We will be adding \$500 - \$900 to the 2022 Budget for cameras. We are also evaluating security systems at the Canyon Springs and King Meadows Stations.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES:**

Q4 Statutory District To-Do List: There are no updates/changes at this time.

Policies and Procedures Manual Revisions Process: Still working on revisions.

Strategic Plan Revisions: Still waiting on input/feedback.

Discussion of Latest COVID trends, etc.:

**Motion:** It was moved by Harvey Ammel and seconded by Scott Fullerton to hold the next two meetings (Special Session on October 27 and Regular Board Meeting on November 8) as hybrid meetings and to cancel the November Auxiliary Event (Pancakes & Sausage Breakfast). A brief discussion followed. Chief Norris stated he would like the Thanksgiving/Christmas Loaves & Fishes meal handouts to be exempted from cancellation. The Board agreed. It was decided to make a final decision as to the feasibility of an in-person Christmas Party at the November Board Meeting. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Donations: Cindy stated that the District received \$1,115 in unrestricted donations in September. YTD donations total \$5,110 -- compared to \$3,498 received YTD in 2020 for the same timeframe. For the entire year 2020, total unrestricted donations totaled \$4,731.

Cindy also informed the Board of an anonymous restricted donation received for an Extractor, an Air Dryer, and a Swamp Cooler. The Extractor and Air Dryer have already been ordered; still working on ordering the Swamp Cooler.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Cindy explained an issue concerning the 2021 Holiday Ornament which is offered for the 2021 Holiday Stocking Stuffer initiative. The order form states "Full color imprint appears on both sides." Due to a supplier communications error (with their production team), that statement is incorrect. The full color imprint (TFPD logo) is on one side only. The other side is a mirror backing (it is literally a mirror). She found out about the supplier error after sending out 550+ emails. She plans on clarifying the wording in the next email blast.

Cindy then asked for ideas on how the profit (if any) from the Holiday Stocking Stuffer should be earmarked. Chief Norris mentioned that he recently discovered that the American Red Cross will partner with fire departments to do the training they need, to have the proper forms filled out, and provide the smoke detectors and batteries for installation in people's homes. Chief Norris then suggested that we use any profit toward a Community Safety Program. This would allow for the purchase of batteries, fire blankets, Chimfex Sticks, and other safety equipment for the TFPD Community – as well as safety courses. The Board unanimously agreed.

Harvey had sent an email concerning possible sign ideas in an effort to replace the LED sign currently on the Station property. He asked the Board to review the signs and to let him know what aspects they feel are important such as size, double sided, brighter, etc.

Scott wanted to thank the Zimney's for confirming that they want to allow the King Meadows Station Lease to renew.

Scott is working with a state liaison for questions concerning the Gaming Impact Grant. We need strong documentation that an incident call is directly related to gambling.

Scott mentioned that certain items will be taken off his To-Do List as the items have been addressed at previous meetings.

There will be a Public Budget Hearing on the adoption of the proposed Fiscal Year 2022 District Budget followed by the regular TFPD Board Meeting (in the hybrid format) on Monday, November 8, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., at the Main Station.

It was moved by Harvey Ammel and seconded by Brad Nelson to adjourn the meeting at 3:53 p.m. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.
