



Tallahassee Fire Protection District Minutes of the Public Hearing & Board of Directors Regular/Hybrid Meeting December 13, 2021

Scott Fullerton called the Public Hearing & Regular/Hybrid Meeting to order at 2:09 p.m., on December 13, 2021.

Directors Present: Scott Fullerton, Christopher Parker, Cynthia Boyle, Harvey Ammel (In-person @ TFPD Main Station), and Brad Nelson (by teleconference).
A quorum is present.

Directors Absent: None

Firefighters/Volunteers Present: Chief Mark Norris (In-person @ TFPD Main Station)

Public Present: None

Purpose of Public Hearing & Regular/Hybrid Meeting: To discuss and adopt the proposed Draft 2nd Amendment to the FY 2021 District Budget and to discuss agenda items for the regular monthly Board of Directors Meeting.

PUBLIC INPUT:

No members of the public were present either in-person or by teleconference call.

NOTE: TFPD Notice of Public Hearing was posted on the TFPD website, published in the Canon City Daily Record on 11-12-2021 (with the publisher's affidavit of publication received), and a copy of the proposed amendment (2nd revision) has been available at the Fremont County Clerk's Office since 11-9-2021. No members of the public chose to address the Board concerning this Public Hearing on amending the 2021 District Budget (2nd revision).

Motion: It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adopt Resolution 2021-007 as written, which is the 2nd revision to the 2021 District Budget. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

This concluded the Public Hearing.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Motion: It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adopt the 2022 Budget Message and Resolution 2021-008 as written (to Set Mill Levies); to endorse the Certification of Tax Levies for Non-School Governments and the Financed Purchase of Asset Schedule; and for the TFPD Secretary to make all necessary filings with relevant agencies. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to accept the Treasurer's Report for November 2021. Chris discussed the Treasurer's Report.

In review of the P&L Budget vs. Actual YTD:

- For budgeted income vs. actual, we are up \$121K mostly due to out-of-district deployment income.
- Administrative expenses are over budget by \$15K.

- Operations expenses are under budget by \$16K.
- Total Net Income is \$45K above budget.

In review of the Balance Sheet:

- For Cash, we are within \$500 of the 2020 cash balance.
- Net Income is \$6.3K above the 2020 Net Income balance.

Scott cautioned that when drawing comparisons between 2021 vs. 2020 YTD numbers on the Balance Sheet you need to recall that the monthly results in 2020 used modified GASB accounting (we were transitioning) and 2021 is the first year we used GASB accounting throughout the year. Entries were made on 12-31-2020 to finalize the transition and provide fiscal year results consistent with GASB. Therefore, the first opportunity for an “apples-to-apples” YTD comparison between numbers will occur when we close the year and compare fiscal 2020 to fiscal 2021.

Chris and Chief Norris had a previous discussion concerning the accrued points on the Chase credit card. After a brief recap and further discussion, it was decided to cash out the points and deposit the money in the bank instead of using these points to buy gift cards through a third party. Scott will tweak the 2022 budget accordingly.

As confirmation, the Board resolved that we will put the Chase credit card points each year to the Performance Awards budget for the Operations staff. The resolution was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Chris stated that due to time constraints, he was unable to research other investment options that meet Colorado statutes. It was decided to table this task until early next year.

Scott reiterated we are developing a gap between property tax receivables and actual receipts. The County Treasurer explained the gap exists due to delinquent accounts which were liquidated during a tax lien sale held on the Thursday before Thanksgiving. We did receive our December disbursement statement from the County. However, there still remains a gap of thousands of dollars. In January 2022, we will receive a final payment for fiscal year 2021 which will be accrued for on 12/31 (before closing the books for the year). Before the January Board Meeting, if we still see a gap, Scott will ask the County Treasurer for the reconciling item(s).

There being no further discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to authorize the TFPD President and TFPD Treasurer to execute the Bank of the San Juans’ Entity Authorization and any other documents required to open a Public Funds account for the District. Scott explained that the fact that we are adopting the Bank of the San Juans does not mean that we are precluding adding other local banks. This is just the first step in adding diversification to our funds.

There being no further discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Status of QuickBooks License: Chris is approved to purchase a five-user with payroll license.

PRESIDENT’S REPORT:

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Cynthia Boyle to adopt Resolution 2021-009 as written, which provides for the indemnification of Directors, Officers and Employees of the District. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Harvey Ammel to adopt Resolution 2021-010 as written, which calls for the 2022 Regular District Election and appoints the Designated Elections Official (DEO). There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

For clarification purposes, Scott stated that Chris' and Harvey's terms both expire in May 2022. We have appointed Donna Toeroek as the DEO. Board members and Chief Norris will receive a Self-Nomination Form by email from Donna. This form can be used for those interested in doing another term (Christopher and/or Harvey) or for dissemination to individuals that may have interest in becoming a Board member. Key election dates were discussed. If only two individuals submit a Self-Nomination Form by February 28, we can cancel the election. If more than two submissions are received, the election will go forward. All incurred election costs have been incorporated into the 2022 District Budget. Under certain circumstances, if there are fewer than two submissions or no submissions, the Board of County Commissioners may step in and assign Board members.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Christopher Parker to confirm there are no changes to the District's boundaries and the TFPD Secretary shall file the Boundary Letter accordingly. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Brad Nelson to engage Collins, Cole, Flynn, Winn & Ulmer, PLLC as the District's general counsel pursuant to Section 32-1-1001(i), C.R.S. per the Engagement Letter dated November 9, 2021 and distributed to the Board. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Harvey Ammel to endorse and offer the TFPD Fire Chief the revised Employment Agreement dated December 13, 2021. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Scott thanked Chief Norris for his work and patience throughout the year. Chief Norris signed and returned the Employment Agreement during the meeting.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Christopher Parker to accept the CSD Pool Workers Compensation Proposal and pay associated premiums. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Harvey Ammel to accept the CSD Pool Property and Liability Proposal, request changes to certain deductibles and pay associated premiums. Scott directed the Board members' attention to the premiums and deductibles pages. Our total premium went up because we substantially increased the insured value of our equipment. For 2020, we were insured for \$1,047,000. This year we are insured for \$1,519,000. Historically for deductibles, we carried a \$1,000 deductible for auto liability and auto physical damage. A discussion ensued concerning the effect of going to higher deductibles. There was a suggestion that in both cases we go from a \$1,000 deductible to either a \$2,500 or a \$5,000 deductible. For auto liability, changing to a \$5,000 deductible would save us \$192 in premium; for auto physical damage changing to a \$5,000 deductible would save us \$867 in premium; bringing us to a combined total premium savings of a little over \$1,000. As we self-repair minor damage to our vehicles and submit a minimal number of claims, we should increase our deductible to bring our premium cost down. Cash balances and budgeted contingency funds would cover a \$5,000 deductible out-of-pocket even in the event of simultaneous damage to several vehicles. It was unanimously agreed to change our deductible to \$5,000 for auto liability and \$5,000 for auto physical damage. Scott to communicate this change to the CSD Pool and will request an adjusted invoice.

There being no further discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

FCC Antenna Renewal Update: Shortly after our last Board Meeting, we received a letter from the FCC that our license was not renewed due to a typo. That typo was corrected, and we have received formal confirmation of our license renewal for the next ten years.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Motion: It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to approve the Public Budget Hearing and Regular Board Meeting Minutes of November 8, 2021. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Motion: It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to accept the 2022 draft Transparency Notice. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

OPERATIONS REPORT:

Chief Norris discussed the highlights of the November Operations Report which included project status:

- 14 incidents in November; 139 total incidents for 2021. We will probably slightly exceed the 2020 total incidents number which was 146.
- 14 active members.
- Tracking differently on the Incident Report. It now shows purely medical, purely fire or purely traffic incidents (which can be a combination of the previously mentioned). The number one incident we respond to is motor vehicle accidents.
- Challenge Coin project is complete. They were handed out at the District Christmas Party.
- Secured the HOA Presentation Handout he wants to use for burning and will forward to Cindy.
- Still trying to secure an EMT Class at the Station – need a certified instructor.
- Response times – Average arrival @ 20.21 minutes for November; 13.31 minutes YTD average.
- Chief Norris and Jenn (TFPD Deployment Coordinator) are working on a Deployment Business Plan for 2022.
- New security cameras have arrived.
- Recently discovered that not only was a catalytic converter stolen from one of our vehicles, but they were also stolen from most of the cars used for the extraction training. Chief Norris is updating the police report with the Sheriff's Office.
- Auto extrication training was held on Saturday, December 11. It was very well attended. The instructor is certified and everyone who attended will receive a certificate. The instructor is also a sales rep for AMKUS Tool. After an evaluation of our current rescue tools, Chief Norris would like to purchase a dedicated spreader (used for motor vehicle accidents) that would enhance our current tooling and will increase our capacity, capability and expediency at motor vehicle incidents. Current price is approximately \$10K and will go up 10-15% after January 1, 2022. In order to secure this year's pricing, we can send in a down payment this month and pay the balance upon delivery – even if delivery happens next year. Scott suggested that some of this expense could be covered by the 2021 unrestricted donations received; with the remainder coming from budgeted discretionary funds. This idea was well received and approved.

Motion: It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Brad Nelson to approve Chief Norris' plan to purchase one AMKUS Tool dedicated spreader and to secure the 2021 pricing as discussed.

There being no further discussion, the Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Chief Norris agreed to provide Cindy with the appropriate wording concerning how the 2021 unrestricted donations will be used for the Donations page of the TFPD website. He also agreed to email photos from the extrication training so she can add to the TFPD website.

Chief Norris stated that Toby Bryant was named Firefighter of the Year. He will provide a head shot and short summary of Toby's accomplishments so that Cindy can add to the TFPD website.

ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES:

Donations: The District received \$782 in unrestricted donations in November; of which \$766 was earmarked for the TFPD Community Safety Program. YTD donations total \$6,207 -- compared to \$4,671 received YTD in 2020. In accordance with the previous discussion and taking into account those donations earmarked for the TFPD Community Safety Program, approximately \$5,200 will be available to help with the purchase of the dedicated spreader.

Q4 Statutory District To-Do List: All tasks for the fourth quarter have been completed. This list has now been updated to show tasks beginning in 2022. Scott thanked Cindy for keeping TFPD on track.

Policies and Procedures Manual Revisions Process: This has been delayed until early 2022 as Kathryn (legal counsel) is in transition with the new legal firm.

OLD BUSINESS:

Stocking Stuffer 2021 Update: Cindy stated that for this initiative, the net gain for 2021 was \$2,061.44 (which is earmarked for the TFPD Community Safety Program) vs. the net gain of \$637.33 for 2020. She asked the Board members to think of ways we can improve community participation in this initiative for 2022. Scott complimented the program for the funds received from the TFPD community and suggested that we continue to fine tune it by determining which inducements were most successful and replacing or eliminating those that were less so.

Director's Reports: There was no discussion.

Holiday Cards and Year-End Thank You Update: Cindy had put together all envelopes per the spreadsheet all Board members had received. These mailings will go out tomorrow, December 14.

NEW BUSINESS:

Potential Property Acquisition for Station and/or Water Tank: Chief Norris stated that he had been notified of a potential property acquisition located within the TFPD Community. This property offers:

- improved capabilities within the area as it has higher density in homes and population than most other areas.
- would not need many improvements – site is mostly buildable so we can add a structure.
- already has potential access for power (can we tap into electrical already there), water (there are good wells in the area) and access to a major county-maintained road (includes snowplowing).

- the ability for TFPD to purchase at a very competitive rate.
- the parcel is already platted and sub-divided.

The first step is doing due diligence which would include:

- Can we get a permit for a driveway?
- Can we tap into the main electrical distribution line already there?
- Can we have it witched, add a well, and add a cistern?

Per Scott (who had already checked into a few things), do we want to proceed with due diligence and expend funds for some incidental fees?

- Per the State Water Board, we should be able to get a fire protection well on the site. They recommended applying for a permit so that we know exactly what water rights we would be able to get. Approximate cost is \$100.
- Per Fremont County, driveway access should not be an issue but recommend applying for the permit so that we know for sure.
- Needs to check with Kathryn (legal counsel) on the latest procedures for a district acquiring property.

Both Brad and Harvey felt this land acquisition was worth looking into as we need a station in this particular area.

Scott also mentioned that we received word on another possible property acquisition near the King Meadows Station. We would need to apply for a well permit.

Should we decide to proceed with the first property (previously discussed in detail), all the necessary steps we would need to take would help answer questions for this second property.

Chris feels we need to work on a capital budgeting strategy for infrastructure build-outs.

Scott received unanimous verbal approval to proceed with due diligence on the first property.

At this point, Brad Nelson disconnected from the teleconference call and left the Board Meeting.

NEXT PUBLIC MEETING:

The next regular TFPD Board Meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 10, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. (by hybrid meeting unless revised), at the Main Station.

MOTION TO ADJOURN:

It was moved by Harvey Ammel and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adjourn the meeting at 3:37 p.m. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

With the adjournment of this regular Board Meeting, Scott Fullerton, Christopher Parker, Cynthia Boyle and Harvey Ammel moved to the Special Study Session to discuss Board tasks and workload.
