



## Tallahassee Fire Protection District Minutes of the Public Budget Hearing & Board of Directors Regular/Hybrid Meeting November 8, 2021

Scott Fullerton called the Public Hearing & Regular/Hybrid Meeting to order at 2:04 p.m., on November 8, 2021.

**Purpose of Public Budget Hearing & Regular/Hybrid Meeting:** To discuss and adopt the proposed 2022 District Budget and to discuss agenda items for the regular monthly Board of Directors Meeting.

---

### **PUBLIC INPUT:**

No members of the public were present either in-person or by teleconference call.

**NOTE:** TFPD Notice of Public Budget Hearing was posted on the TFPD website, published in the Canon City Daily Record on 10-19-2021 (with the publisher's affidavit of publication received), and a copy of the proposed 2022 District Budget has been available at the Fremont County Clerk's Office since 10-14-2021. No members of the public chose to address the Board concerning this Public Budget Hearing on adopting the 2022 District Budget.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT:**

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adopt Resolution 2021-005 as written, which adopts the 2022 District Budget. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to adopt Resolution 2021-006 as written, which calls to appropriate sums of money for the 2022 District Budget. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

The agenda item of a Motion to Adopt the Budget Message was tabled until the December Board Meeting. Once Chris finalizes the Budget Message, it will be emailed to all Board members and it will be officially discussed and approved at the December Board Meeting.

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to approve the Treasurer's Report for October 2021. Chris discussed the Treasurer's Report.

- Cash is relatively stable.
- Total Income is up \$109K over budget. [Clarification added to the printed Minutes by the President: This includes approximately \$77K of income for deployments that is largely offset by deployments-related payroll, payroll taxes and reimbursement of responder expenses. A reader may not be aware of this, but the Board is aware because of discussions at previous meetings.]

- Total Administrative Expenses are up.
- Payroll, Taxes & Benefits and Personnel costs are below budget.
- Fire Operations Expenses are above budget by approximately 20%.
- Total Operations Expenses are approximately \$14K below budget.
- Net Income (increase in retained funds) is up 288% due to Deployment Income Out-of-District.

Scott explained why Receivables are so high: We have made partial payments to responders for their deployments, but we have not received all the funds from the State for submitted claims (the receivable). Once TFPD gets paid, deployments receivables will go to zero and our cash balance will go up due to the additional income. This is common and we expect to be fully paid by the end of the year or, worst case, early January.

Scott reminded everyone that we can only have one Payroll Tax account within QuickBooks. We are unable to split payroll taxes which are related to Operations, Deployments, and stipends. So, we are currently understated in Operations, but overstated in Administration. Payroll Taxes will be moved to a single account for budgeting and reporting purposes beginning in 2022.

There was no further discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to review and accept the proposed 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021 District Budget which reflects the effects of recent deployments, to make public notice of a Public Hearing at the Regular Board Meeting on December 13, 2021, and to provide a copy of the amended District Budget for review at the Fremont County Clerk's Office and to post on the TFPD website.

The amendment is needed due to:

- Deployments (both income and expenses).
- Restricted donation received where a portion was used to purchase a swamp cooler; with the remaining portion going toward the TFPD Community Safety Program.
- Corrections/adjustments due to actual income/expenses since the 1<sup>st</sup> Amended 2021 Budget.
- Increasing the potential expense for Property & Liability Insurance due to some changes in insured values.

There was no further discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to engage Erickson, Brown & Kloster, P.C. (successor to Osborne, et al.) to prepare the State of Colorado Application for Exemption from Audit for Fiscal Year 2021. Their fee has increased by \$75. Chris to sign the Engagement Letter. There was no further discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

**Motion:** It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to discuss the Local Government Investment Pool options for District funds and authorize next steps. Both Scott and Chris stated they like COLOTRUST. Cindy stated she was uncomfortable investing property owner tax monies that presented even an infinitesimal chance of losing some of that money – especially while the rate of return is so low. She felt any investment needed to be FDIC insured – which COLOTRUST is not. Scott would like to see our funds diversified among multiple institutions/accounts – whether in an investment fund or distributed to a few local, state-licensed banks.

Due to this conversation, the **Motion** was changed to: It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Scott Fullerton to forgo one of the investment trusts for now but to proceed with diversifying our funds to no less than two state-approved banks in government accounts. After further discussion, Scott remained committed to diversification, Chris would like to invest with COLOTRUST and is satisfied with the security of the trust, Brad had no comment, and Harvey would be OK with either approach but agreed with Cindy's point that currently the slight risk is not worth the rate of return. Chris pledged to do more research on investment strategies that are FDIC insured and meet the Colorado statutes for local government investments. The Motion was tabled until further research is completed.

Status of the QuickBooks license: Chris is to obtain this license so that we may begin the conversion process this fiscal year.

Status of Bank Transition: Chris stated that we continue to have internal issues with Wells Fargo. There being no objections, it was agreed that Scott and Chris should begin the process of opening up an account at the Bank of the San Juans, in Canon City.

## **PRESIDENT'S REPORT:**

Property & Liability Insurance Renewal Briefing: Scott had a conversation with individuals at the CSD Pool ("the Pool"). As background, we have completed forms detailing what has changed in the last year which were sent to the Pool and we are now awaiting quotes. We should receive a quote package soon and we will be able to discuss coverage at the December Board Meeting. Scott met with Chief Norris and Chris to discuss our insurance renewal. Highlighted areas include:

- We need to change the coverage on our vehicles. We learned that we have undervalued the replacement cost of engines historically and, more recently, there has also been a spike in the cost of vehicles due to inflation, manufacturing backlogs and speculative purchases of used engines because of the increase in wildfires. For the current quote, we increased the replacement cost of our vehicles to match the current market conditions. When the spike goes down, we have the option to change that value at any time. We will receive a quote based on these higher values and our current deductibles (which are relatively low). We can then assess whether we want to increase our deductibles to partially or fully offset any premium increases based on the new values.
- There is an additional insurance option for Auxiliary Events. However, we would need to legally restructure the Auxiliary to utilize it. Scott to ask Legal Counsel for an assessment on the advantages, disadvantages, and costs of a possible restructure. It's been several years since we looked into this and there may be other reasons to restructure.

**Motion:** It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Harvey Ammel to retain Collins Cole Flynn Winn & Ulmer, PLLC, as District Counsel effective January 1, 2022, and to authorize the TFPD President to execute any agreements required to formalize that relationship and facilitate the transfer of files from Collins Cockrel & Cole, P.C ("CC&C"). CC&C is splitting into two firms. Our "new" counsel is the one specializing in Special Districts and similar governmental entities. Scott will sign the letter sent by CC&C in order to get the transfer process started. As an end result, we will compose a formal Resolution specifying this retention of counsel. There was no further discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

FCC Antenna Renewal: Scott confirmed that our FCC License has been renewed for another ten years.

## **SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

**Motion:** It was moved by Cynthia Boyle and seconded by Scott Fullerton to approve the regular Board Meeting Minutes for October 11, 2021, the Special Session Minutes for October 13, 2021, and the Public Hearing and Special Session Minutes for October 27, 2021. There were no responses to the request for discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Confirmation of Filing and Acceptance of the Amended 2021 District Budget (1<sup>st</sup> revision) by DOLA: Cindy confirmed that the adopted Amended 2021 District Budget (1<sup>st</sup> revision) and the corresponding Resolution had been e-filed to DOLA. DOLA sent an email stating our Amended Budget had been approved.

## **OPERATIONS REPORT:**

Chief Norris discussed the highlights of the October Operations Report which included Project Status, Operations Christmas Party and Challenge Coin Status:

- 8 incidents in October; 125 total incidents for 2021.
- Membership remains consistent. Chief Norris did talk to a gentleman in our District who is an active Paramedic and is interested in helping us out with training and response.
- Custom Challenge Coins – The design is done and the coins have been ordered. They should be received in time for the Operations Christmas Party. All TFPD Responders will receive five personalized coins. Each Auxiliary Committee member will receive one personalized coin. Also ordered Keychain Challenge Coins for all members using the generic District Coin design.
- Response times – Average arrival @ 15.30 minutes for October; 12.45 minutes YTD average.
- Per the anonymous restricted donation, the new PPE Extractor/Washer and PPE Air Dryer have been received and installed.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES:**

Donations: The District received \$315 in unrestricted donations in October; of which \$200 was earmarked for the TFPD Community Safety Program. YTD donations total \$5,425 -- compared to \$4,418 received YTD in 2020. We also received an anonymous restricted donation of \$4,999 (\$3,992 for a Swamp Cooler for the Main Station and \$1,007 in support of the TFPD Community Safety Program).

Discussion of Latest COVID Trends, etc.:

**Motion:** It was moved by Scott Fullerton and seconded by Christopher Parker that based on the vaccination rates in Fremont County, projections from the State regarding cases and anticipated hospital bed shortages through January 2022, that we cancel the Cookies & Cocoa with Santa Auxiliary Event which has been scheduled for December 18, 2021. In addition, until further notice, all Board Meetings whether Regular or Special Sessions will be in the hybrid format. A lengthy discussion followed to the first segment of this Motion with Scott providing COVID statistics/trends for Fremont County and other pertinent information from the Fremont County Public Health Department and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Of key importance is that our core mission is to provide fire, medical and rescue services to the TFPD Community and this will always be our primary focus. We are not willing to do anything that would put our mission at risk. The Board also agreed to the hybrid format for future Board Meetings. There was no further discussion. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

Q4 Statutory District To-Do List: This list remains unchanged since the last submission.

Strategic Plan Revisions: Scott Fullerton put forth a resolution which was seconded by Brad Nelson that instead of doing a formal Strategic Plan, we put forth a one sentence Strategic Plan which is: For the year 2022, TFPD's primary focus will be to increase the number of trained, actively participating responders in all specialties; and that future strategic opportunities will be assessed based on the people available to build and maintain them. We have learned that our critical path is people. We must focus on bringing in people with needed skills, see what we learn, and in time, turn that into strategic objectives. The Board unanimously agreed.

Cindy stated that, in time, she would like to get input from Scott and Chief Norris to ensure the TFPD website is updated accordingly with this new Strategic Plan and volunteer opportunities. They agreed.

Policies and Procedures Manual Revisions: Scott stated that this is tabled for now, but it is in the queue.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Stocking Stuffer 2021 Update: There were no questions regarding the Sales Analysis Cindy had previously distributed. Sales could be better. Cindy will send her final Stocking Stuffer email blast next week. She stated that she is running low on the Tote Bags inventory and requested permission to purchase additional bags when her supplier offers a good discount. The Board agreed.

Director's Reports: There was no discussion.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Holiday Cards and Year-End Thank Yous: Cindy designed and ordered (with Scott's permission) a TFPD Holiday Card which will be sent to those individuals that made a monetary donation or supported the Holiday Stocking Stuffer in 2021. Scott offered the idea to include a TFPD 2021 Holiday Ornament with the TFPD Holiday Card to those individuals/companies that made a substantial contribution to TFPD in 2021 whether by donations (monetarily or non-monetarily) or by effort. All Board members and Chief Norris thought this was a good idea and are to submit their choice(s) for those they feel should be recognized to Cindy. All will be reviewed and discussed at the December Board Meeting. Delivery of these cards/ornaments will be determined too.

Cindy stated she would like to donate a few TFPD branded items for the Loaves & Fishes Thanksgiving Meals which Misty will be distributing. With the Board's permission, it was decided to include an EMI packet, a magnetic bag clip, and a car/window decal. In December, Cindy will also include a few items for the Loaves & Fishes Christmas Meals distribution.

Scott informed the Board that we learned we are now able to accept debit and credit card payments in addition to PayPal account transfers through the TFPD website. Cindy had initiated a conversation with the Colorado help desk which supports our website in getting this payment option added to the footer. It now appears on the TFPD website but we would like to make some minor adjustments to the receipt an individual receives and the transmittal sent to our Treasurer. Currently, all payments are shown as a "donation" on the receipt with no other information. Ideally, we would like to configure this documentation to show the type of donation: generic/unrestricted, part of an appeal like Stocking Stuffer, etc. Chief Norris mentioned that he ran a PayPal store in the past and would be willing to look into this for us.

**NEXT PUBLIC MEETING:**

There will be a Public Hearing on the adoption of the proposed 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021 District Budget followed by the regular TFPD Board Meeting (in the hybrid format) on Monday, November 8, 2021, at 2:00 p.m., at the Main Station.

**MOTION TO ADJOURN:**

It was moved by Christopher Parker and seconded by Brad Nelson to adjourn the meeting at 3:32 p.m. The Motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.
